The Diocese of Lubbock: Deaneries

"In order to foster pastoral care through common action, several neighboring parishes can be joined together into special groups such as vicariates forane (deaneries), commonly called 'vicariates (deaneries)'. The vicariate is under the direction of a 'vicar (dean), 'who represents the bishop and aids the various pastors and ministers in the area sharing pastoral resources." (Canon 374§2)

The division of the diocese into deaneries is not obligatory, but in large dioceses the bishop usually entrusts to certain priests known as "deans" or "vicars forane" the oversight of a portion of his diocese and generally delegates to them special jurisdictional powers during their term of office.

Because the Diocese of Lubbock covers such a large area (more than 23,000 square miles), Bishop Robert M. Coerver, has established the Brownfield, Lubbock, Plainview, and Snyder Deaneries.

May 23, 2025, Bishop Robert M. Coerver made an Official Decree creating the East Lubbock Deanery and West Lubbock Deanery. This change is effective July 1, 2025.
